

7 Internet Safety Tips for Parents

Even the internet has bullies. This can happen anywhere with internet access. Teach your child that if someone is being mean to them or threatens them to tell an adult and show them the messages right away!

6.) **Monitor your child's web access.**

7.) **Block certain websites.**
